SEGMENT 1 COURSE PROVISIONS

- 1. School Dayz Driving School, LLC will provide a minimum of 24 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of behind-the-wheel (BTW) instruction, and 4 hours of observation time in a dual controlled automobile, fully insured, covering each student enrolled in the program.
- 2. Classroom instruction must be a minimum of 3 weeks in length.
- 3. BTW instruction shall not begin until the student has received a minimum of 4 hours of classroom instruction.
- 4. BTW instruction must be completed no later than 3 weeks after the classroom instruction has been completed.

TERMS

- 1. The student must be at least 14 years 8 months of age by the first scheduled day of class (verification by birth certificate required).
- 2. The parent or guardian agrees to pay the amount of \$270.00 which can be paid in 3 easy installments. The first payment of \$100 is due at registration, the second payment of \$100 is due on the 2nd Monday of class, and the final payment of \$70 is due on the 3rd Monday of class. Failure to make a payment will result in the student not being able to attend class until payment is made & is subject to term #8
- 3. Requirements to pass the course: Students must participate in class discussions, activities and complete all work on time. Missing and/or incomplete assignments will result in automatic failure of the Segment I course.
- 4. The required score to pass the STATE TEST is 70%.
